

JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS'
PROCEEDINGS
August 17, 2009

At 9:00 A.M., Chair Burgmeier called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Stephen Burgmeier, Chair; Richard C. Reed, Vice-Chair; Lee Dimmitt, Supervisor.

It was moved by Dimmitt that the minutes for the August 10, 2009 meeting be acknowledged. All "Aye". Motion carried.

The Board met with the County Engineer and the Assistant County Attorney.

It was moved by Reed that the following amount be authorized to be transferred during the fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. Transfers are to be made monthly and shall not exceed in total for the year \$879,192 from the Rural Basic Fund and \$20,002 from the General Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund. All "Aye". Motion carried.
