

**JEFFERSON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS’
PROCEEDINGS
July 30, 2018**

At 9:00 A.M., Chair Sandquist called the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors to order.

Board members present were: Dee Sandquist, Chairman; Lee Dimmitt, Vice-Chairman; Richard C. Reed, Supervisor.

It was moved by Dimmitt that the minutes for the July 23rd, 2018 meeting be acknowledged. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

Supervisors met with Dave Harper, Superintendent for Pekin School District regarding building projects and the secondary roads Birch, Butternut and 110th.

The Board met with the County Engineer.

Motion was made by Reed to set the public hearing on vacating closed portion of Osage Avenue, south of US Highway 34 and north of road closure barricade for August 20, 2018 at 9:30 A.M. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt that the uncollectable taxes from a prior owner’s mobile home, which normally would be assessed against the following:

are hereby abated, for the above amount. Dimmitt “Aye”. Sandquist “Aye”. Reed “Nay”. Motion carried.

Dimmitt made a motion to table consideration of the Re-Plat of Lot 1 of Drish Minor Subdivision until next Monday. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Reed to allow the chair to sign the Business Property Tax Credit applications with approval or disallowance as the Assessor has recommended. All “Aye”. Motion carried.

It was moved by Dimmitt that the disposal system contractor's license for Leichty & Son Construction Inc. be reinstated. All "Aye". Motion carried.

Reed reported on a call from Dick DeAngelis requesting a letter regarding the value seen by the Board of Supervisors in his films. Dimmitt reported on his 10-15 Transit meeting and his meeting with the County nuisance compliance officer to work on the nuisance letter. Sandquist reported on her FEDA meeting and Mental Health panel with Fred Hubbell she'd attended. Sandquist also reported that she'd spoken to Rotary on hunger and gave a Board of Supervisors update.

Public comments: None.

It was moved by Reed to allow the claims against the county and to direct the county auditor to issue checks against the various funds of the county in payment of the claims allowed. All "Aye". Motion carried.
