Fee: *There is a \$100 fee for the inspection. If the system fails, the fee will cover the construction permit necessary to replace or repair the system. There may be other costs associated with the inspection: pumping the septic tank, BOD test, filter, etc.*

Note: *The person having the inspection done is responsible for having the septic tank inspection ports accessible and easy to open. There are typically 3 ports on a septic tank: the inlet, outlet and center or pumping cover. There are low interest loans available to help upgrade failed septic systems.*
